NURSING ACADEMY COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS

A nursing-focused approach to completing 36 credit hours of undergraduate coursework toward the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN). All of the courses that do not have a lab component can be taken online, making it convenient to add the courses to your normal high school schedule. The lab courses, BIO 222 and BIO 223 (Anatomy and Physiology I & II) and CHEM 253 (Chemical Perspectives on Life), are offered on the AU main campus in our state-of-the art facilities.



You Could Be Eligible for \$4,000 in Scholarships!

All high school students in the Class of 2024 and beyond who are enrolled in the College Credit Plus program at AU and who matriculate directly from high school into a bachelor's program will receive a yearly \$1,000 scholarship (\$500 to be awarded in the fall semester and \$500 in the spring semester). This scholarship is renewable each year (for up to four years, or \$4,000), and is stackable upon other scholarships/aid.

By completing the courses in the CCP Nursing Academy below, you will be on track to complete the B.S. in Nursing (BSN) after high school in just three years!

^{**}The Critical Cultural Inquiry (CCI) requirement can be completed by either one value-added foreign language course, an approved study-away or study abroad experience or one CCI course.

The **Bachelor of Science in Nursing** degree is comprised of the following types of courses:

- Institutional Core Courses (these are taken by ALL AU students, AKA "Core" or "Gen Ed" courses)
- **Prerequisite, Non-Nursing Courses** required by the nursing major which provide a foundation for nursing coursework (such as BIO 222/223, MATH 108 and CHEM 253 in the CCP Pathway).
- Courses in the Nursing Major (such as those courses with the NUR prefix in the 3-Year Curriculum Track above). Students must apply and be admitted to the nursing program before taking any NUR coursework.
- Total Hours: (CCP Nursing Academy, 36 hours) + (3-Year Traditional Track above, 90 hours) = 126 credit hours

CCP Nursing Academy – Additional Information

The CCP Nursing Academy pathway includes 36 credit hours to be completed while the student is still in high school.

- CCP students are limited to a total of 30 credit hours per school year. This means it will take at least two years to complete the nursing academy while in the College Credit Plus program.
- Any high school courses taken are included in the 30-hour total. Your high school counselor can help you calculate how many credit hours you have available to "spend" on CCP courses.

How to Apply to AU's Nursing Program After High School

- Submit an application at ashland.edu/apply.
 - Instead of creating a new account, login with the credentials you created when you applied to the College Credit Plus program (click on *Returning Users*) and start a new undergraduate application.
 - o Declare nursing as your major.
 - o To be admitted directly into the nursing program, you must have a 3.0 HS GPA and an ACT composite score of 20 or higher. The admissions office will also review your CCP (college) GPA.
 - Traditional college students have the option of selecting whether they want to be considered for test-optional or traditional admission, whereas in CCP, a CCP advisor will automatically admit a student as long as the requirements for either pathway are met. It is suggested that intended nursing majors always submit test scores, especially if they have a composite score of 20 or higher.
- If you are admitted directly into the nursing program, an advisor will review your CCP credit and create your degree plan. If you desire to complete the 3-year BSN pathway outlined in the CCP Nursing Academy, please include this information in your communication with your advisor.

Please take your participation in College Credit Plus seriously.

- When applying to the nursing program, your admission will rely predominately on your HS GPA and ACT score; however, if you have completed the CCP nursing academy pathway, your grades in BIO 222, BIO 223, and CHEM 253 will be reviewed.
- If you earned a C- or lower in any of those courses, it is considered a nursing course failure. Students earning a C- or lower in 2 or more science required nursing major courses (BIO 222, 223, 240, CHEM 251, 253) would be DISMISSED from nursing or not allowed to pursue nursing.
- From the Nursing handbook/college catalog:
 - Pre-licensure students who receive a grade of "C-"or below in two required science courses will be automatically dismissed from the nursing program, but not from Ashland University.
- Also students MUST earn a C or higher in all nursing major required courses. For the pathway this includes MATH 108, PHIL 215, BIO 222, BIO 223, and CHEM 253.

Please consult with your school counselor to determine which courses you need to satisfy HS graduation requirements.
